Appendix K2 - Course K2 Diagram

The course will be an triangular one with all starts from the Committee Boat, Mary Flora (yellow wooden hull), on the leeward side of the course.

The start line will be between the Committee Boat and a pin displaying an orange flag.

The Finish Line will be between a separate Finish Boat, Drifter (a Westerley), and a pin displaying a blue flag to its port.

An alternative finish line will be formed between the Start Committee Boat and a pin displaying a blue flag to its starboard.

Course A – Triangular

First Round : Start – 1 – 2 - 3

Subsequent : 1 – 2 – 3

Final : 1 – 2 – 3 – Finish

Course B – Windward/Leeward

First Round : Start – 1 – 3

Subsequent : 1 – 3

Final : 1 – 3 – Finish

Course C – Olympic Triangle

Round 1 : Start – 1 – 2 – 3

Round 2 : 1 – 3

Round 3 : 1 – 2 - 3

Round 4 : 1 – 3 – Finish

Course E – Coastal Course (PY and Sonatas)

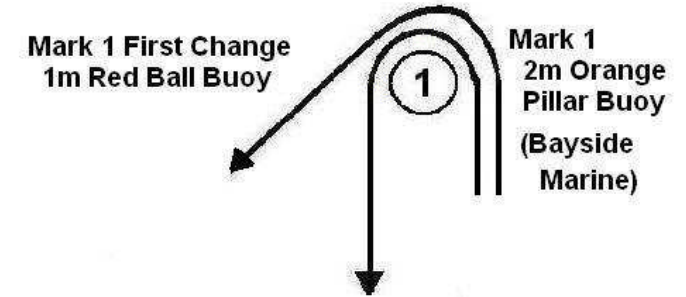

IF Flag G is displayed on the Committee Boat at the Start, all boats MUST go through the Gate comprising the Finish Line upwind of the Leeward mark, on EVERY upwind Leg EXCEPT the first round AND MUST NOT pass through this gate on any downwind leg.

If Flag A is displayed, the Alternative Finish Line is used.

The number of laps to be sailed will be indicated on a board - see SI 9.5.
